The 2015 Programme

In the 2015 programme you will find a number of different events. These are either 'point-to-point' races (usually the Classics), 'Circuit' races that are either short and sharp criterium style, or longer Road style, and 'Handicap' races where riders of different ability all race toward the finish with different starting times representative of their levels.

Also included in the programme are a series of Time Trial events pitting you against both the clock and your fellow competitors.

Races build to a crescendo throughout the season taking in the Otago Champs, a hotly contested race weekend, to find the best Otago rider.

Other races follow a historical route and take in some of the most beautiful roads Otago has to offer. On weekends where there are no competitive races often a club social ride or sportive is planned.

Races start promptly at the time stated, and the report times or handicapping/TT entry details need to be taken into account for the programme to run smoothly.
