



Cycling Otago – Road Event Calendar: 2020 Spring into Summer

This format for our calendar has the intention of publishing all details at the start of each season to provide time for planning and training. This copy is a work in progress and it will be progressively updated as event particulars are confirmed.

Please note that we support some main events from other neighbouring cycling clubs and they support our main events (plus we enjoy having their Cups in our trophy cabinet). This is limited at the moment, as many other commercial races are currently restricted by COVID-19 Level 2 restrictions. Make the effort to travel to other events at other clubs, they are well run, good events and a lot of fun. Also see the links to their websites on the last page.

General:

- All rules and instructions of the race manager must be obeyed; failure to follow them may result in disqualification or stand down
- It is compulsory to attend the race briefing prior to start time
- Our events are held on public roads, at all times the requirements of the Road Rules and Traffic Management Plan apply

Road Race Numbers:

All riders participating in Club races must wear a race number during every race. No number, no race!

A club race number can be assigned to each club member and it should be used for the whole year. [Race Registration:](#)

Registration for all races is done online through the [Cycling Otago Webscorer](#) page. As each event is set up within a couple weeks of the race, it will be advertised on the Cycling Otago Facebook page.

Entry Fee:

Entry fees are variable per event and details are provided when the registration portal opens. Generally, fees are set for licensed riders registered through Cycling NZ (e.g. through Cycling Otago or other clubs) and non-licensed riders.

Club Membership and Race Licence:

In order to be eligible for event points or prizes, competitors must be CNZ licensed. Membership of the Cycling Otago club includes the CNZ license.

Handicap Racing ETIQUETTE

In Handicap races, riders are expected to share the pace-making with their co-markers – rotating from the start of the race. If they are unable to keep this up, they may take a short rest at the back of the bunch before re-joining in the shared pace-making. If they rest at the back for a long period or are unable to contribute to the pace of the mark, it would be seen as un-sportsman-like for them to then compete for the finishing places or to take a major prize from the co-markers.

Race Cancellations:

If the race is cancelled due to weather conditions or other causes, an alert will be posted on the Cycling Otago Facebook page.

Being a Manager or Marshall:

This is always a challenge for the club to organise and consideration of a new streamlined process is currently been worked though.

If you have not volunteered to date for a duty in this programme, then please raise your hand now or when we need extras / when the cry for help goes out to support an event. In order to run our races we are reliant on the goodwill and support of the many great people in the club (as well as their friends and family).
